#### STEP-1: Connect your computer to the router

1-1. Connect your computer to the router by cable or wireless, then login the router by entering http://192.168.1.1 into the address bar of your browser.



Note:The default access address differs by model. Please find it on the bottom label of the product.

1-2. Please click **Setup Tool** icon



to enter the router's setting interface.



1-3. Please login to the Web Setup interface (the default user name and password is **admin**).
