A: The blades should be sharpened regularly or when you notice a decrease in cutting efficiency. Refer to the maintenance section in the manual for guidance on blade sharpening.

# **USING THE PRUNING SCISSORS**

• INSERT THE BATTERY INTO THE POWER CONNERCTOR OF THE PRUNER;



• SWITCH ON THE POWER SWITCH OF THE PRUNNER. DUE TO THE FIRST TIME USAGE THAT THE LED DISPLAY INDICATOR WILL BE GREEN AND THE BUZZER WILL BUZZ FOR 2 TIMES;



• DOUBLE CLICK THE TRIGGER, THE PRUNER BLADES WILL AUTOMATICALLY OPEN;



• NORMAL PRUNING: PRESS TRIGGER TO CLOSE THE BLADES AND RELEASE THE TRIGGER TO OPEN BLADES;



• BLADE CLOSURE: CONTINUE TO PRESS THE TRIGGER, A CONTINUAL BUZZ ME-ANS THE BLADE WILL STAY CLOSED;



• BEFORE OPERATION, IN ORDER TO SEE IF THE PRUNER FUNCTIONS WELL, PLE-ASE PRESS THE TRIGGER TO CLOSE AND RELEASE THE TRIGGER TO OPEN THE BLADES WITHOUT CUTTING ANYTHING. REPEAT THIS FOR FEW TIMES;



# PRUNING SCISSORS LUBRICATION

• THERE IS A OIL FILLING PORT AT THE REVERSE OF THE PRUNER, TAKE OUT THE COTTON;



• PLACE THE OIL BOTTLE NOZZLE IN THE LUBRICATING PORT. HOLD THE OIL BOTT- LE UPRIGHT AND THEN LUBRIFIE;



• ONCE LUBRICATION IS COMPLETE, PLUG THE COTTON;



• OPERATE THE PRUNER, MAKE THE LUBRICATION IS WELL PROPORTIONED;





## **CHANGE THE BLADE**

• USING THE PHILIPS HEAD TIP ON THE TOOL, UNSCREW THE TOW SCREWS AND REMOVE COVER;



• USING THE OTHER TIP OF THE SPECIAL TOOL, REMOVE SCREW AND THE ELAS-TOMER WASHER;



• AGAIN USING THE SPECIAL TOOL, REMOVE LOCKED SCREW NUT AND REMOVE RESISTANCE WASHER;



• REMOVE THE BLADE AND REPLACE THE BLADE;



### **WARRANTY TERM**

This product is guaranteed against defects in material and workmanship for a legal period of three (3) months from the date of issue of the respective Sales Invoice. We undertake to repair or replace, within the period mentioned, free of charge, parts that are recognized by the Technical Department as defective, upon approval of the Warranty Request. This warranty is limited and non-transferable, valid only for the first purchaser and covers only the product, all damages and losses resulting from misuse of the equipment are excluded. Any freight/insurance and other costs will be borne by the buyer.

The following shall be excluded from the guarantee:

- Defects caused by use not in accordance with the instructions contained in the Owner's Manual; accidents (falling, fire, etc.); use of non-original parts and repairs and / or maintenance carried out by unauthorized workshops and / or technicians.
- Spare parts and natural maintenance such as spark plugs, lubricants, filters, fuel cap, starting cord, handles, seals, gaskets, safety devices and similar items.
- Parts that suffer from natural wear and tear due to friction such as piston, cylinder, piston rings, bearings, pins,

rollers, connecting rod, crankshaft, springs, bushings, rotor and mechanical seals.

- · Violated products.
- Products whose Certificate of Warranty is incorrectly filled in and / or without the Sales Invoice number.
  NOTE: A breakdown during the warranty period does not entitle the buyer to stop payment, or discounts.
