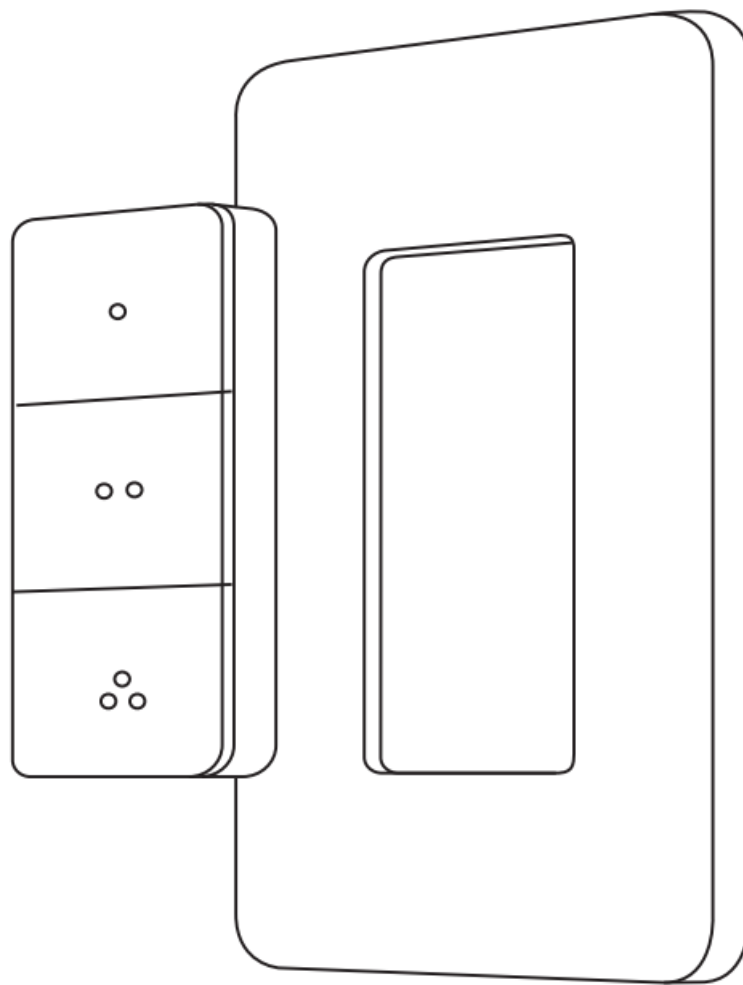

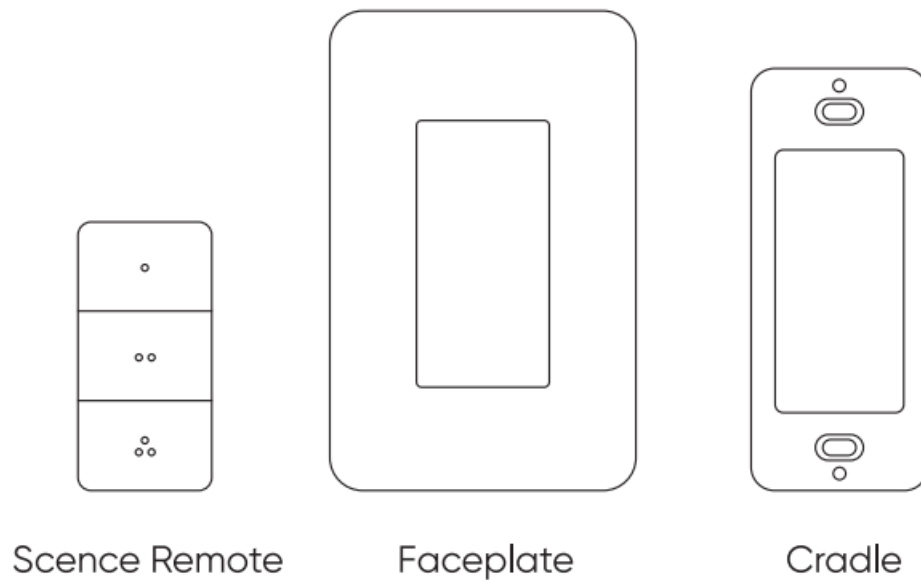

Introduction

Treatlife Scene Remote connects to the Treatlife App and allows you to control a group of lights across your home or trigger specific preset scenes, just press the button to light the way, even if you forget your phone. It can be mounted almost anywhere, or it can be used as a handheld remote.

What's in the box



Accessories included:
adhesive tape, CR2032 battery, screw, setup guide.

Getting started

To get started make sure that you have:

1. AniOS or Android device
2. Good wifi signal
3. The Treatlife App, available on the App Store or Google Play
4. ATreatlife Smart Hub (Sold Separately)

Quick setup

11 Scan the QR code below or search Treatlife in the App Store or Google Play to download the App, and register an account according to the instruction on the Treatlife App.

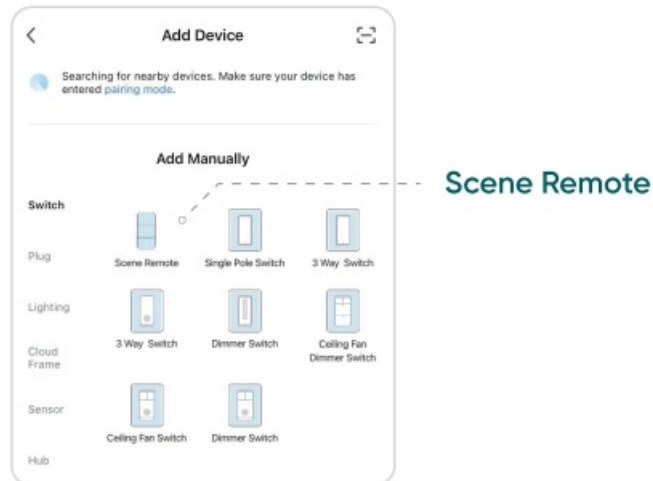

1.2 Connect the Smart Hub to the Treatlife App according to the quick guide for the hub.



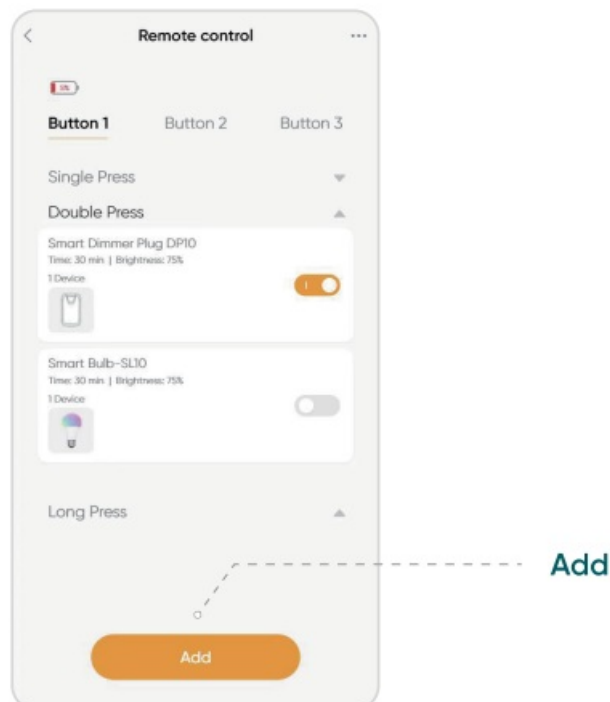
1.3 Click "Add device" button on the top right, click the "Switch" on the left and select the "Scene Remote" and follow the setup guide to get it paired,



Set up actions

You can set up to 9 actions on the Treatlife Smart Scene Remote, 3 for each button (single press, double press and long press).

Open the Scene Remote page, click "Add", select one action you prefer, then assign a scene or device



Example scenes



Bedtime:

Place the Scene Remote on your bedside table.
Before sleeping, press to turn off all your home lights,



Entertainment:

Place the Scene Remote on your coffee table.
When ready to party, press to dim the lights

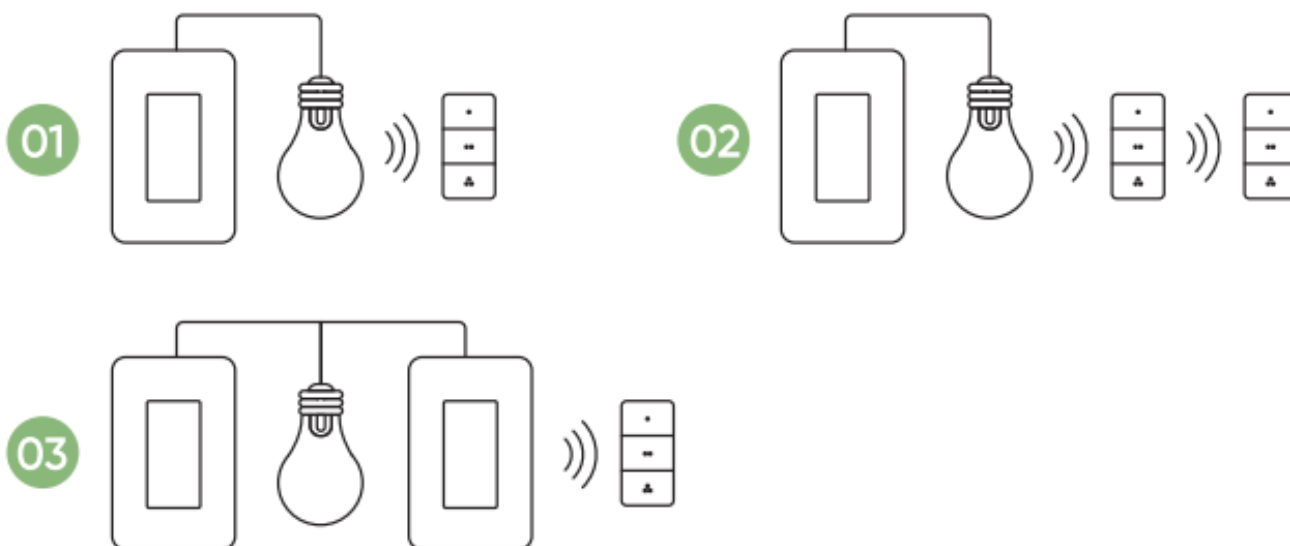


Guest room on/off:

Give guests control of smart lights, from multiple locations:

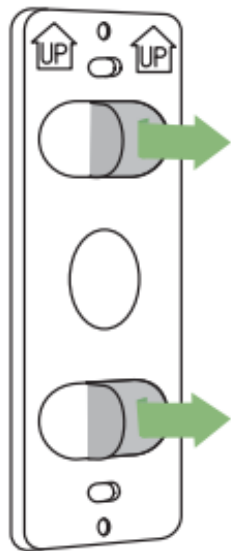
Create Multi-way Control to Your Lights

Add the handheld remote to Treat the single pole or 3-way switch to control the lights from multiple locations.

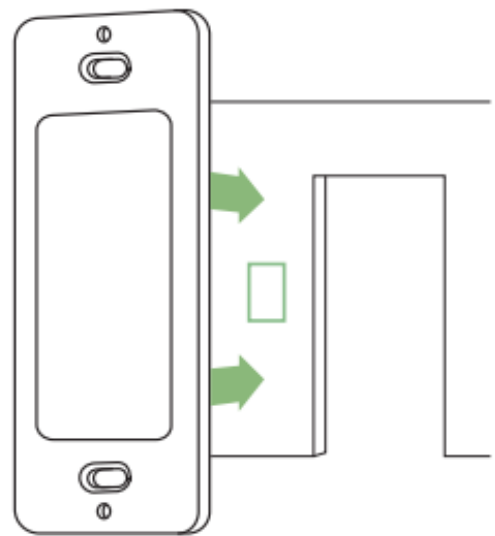


Wall-mounting

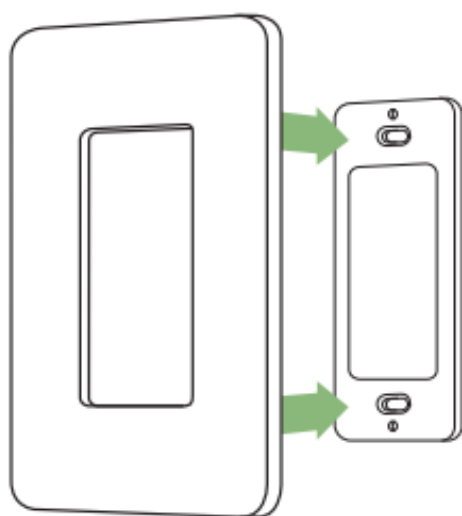

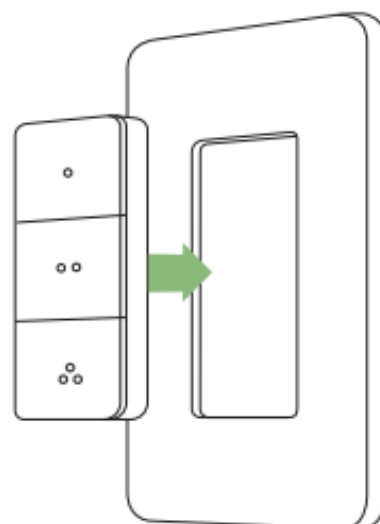
Thoroughly clean wall surface. Remove the paper from the adhesive strips on the back of the cradle

Attach the cradle to the wall

Snap the faceplate onto the mounted cradle.

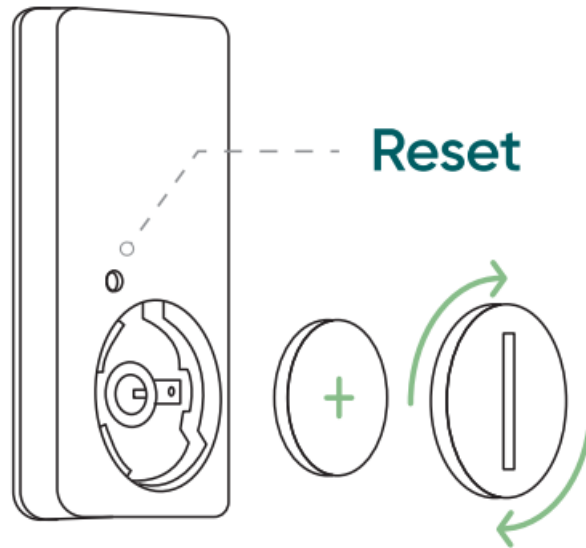
A magnet in the controller holds it to the wall mount

Changing the battery

To change the battery you need to follow these steps:

Twisting the battery cover on the left to open. Remove the old battery and replace it with a new CR2032 battery with the '+' side up.

Place back the cover and twist to the right until it clicks.



Note: consider that the adhesive is super strong before you stick it to any surface. Removing the adhesive might cause damage to the surface attached.

Troubleshooting

Restart

Have setup or control issues? Remove and re-insert the battery to restart,

Restore factory settings

If the restart doesn't help, restore factory settings.

1. Press and hold Restore button for seconds
2. Wait until the indicator blinks, then release:
3. Re-add your Scene Remote to the Treatife App. and re-assign scenes to buttons
