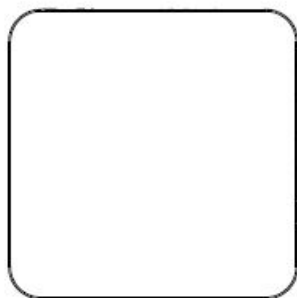

## Installation Steps

### Connect to the 1V

The 1V box has HDMI HD output and AV Composite video output functions. Connect to the 1V with HDMI cable and enjoy HD content.

### Connect to the Network

The 1V box supports wire and wireless network. Wire network: Please insert the network cable before starting the 1V box. Wireless network: Start 1V box and choose the WiFi hotspot and input the password to finish the connection.

### Connect the mouse

Connect the mouse to use the 1V box. Finish! Enjoy bulk videos from Internet easily.

### Boot

Connect the power to boot the 1V box.
