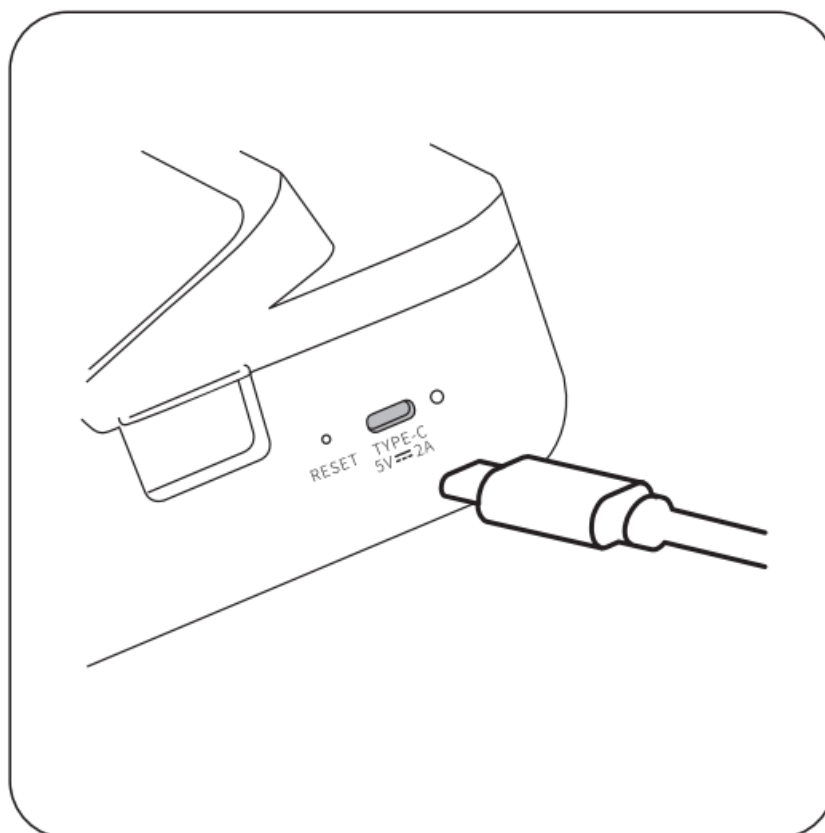


Vixic D480BT Label Maker Machine with Tape

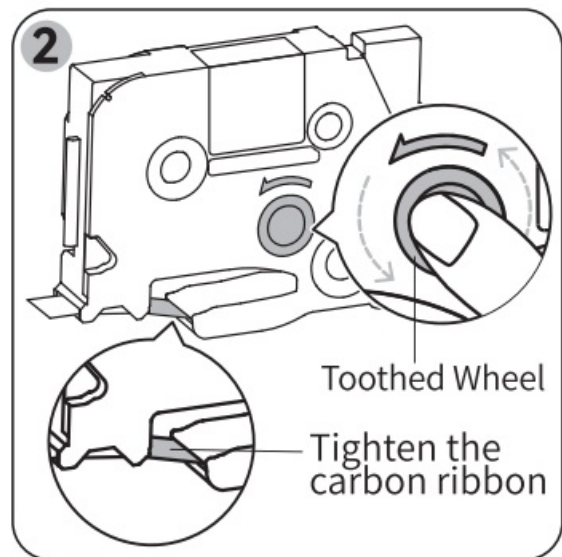
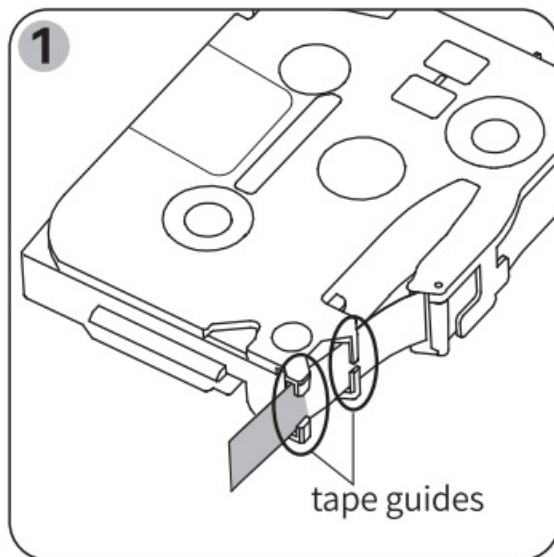


INSTALLATION

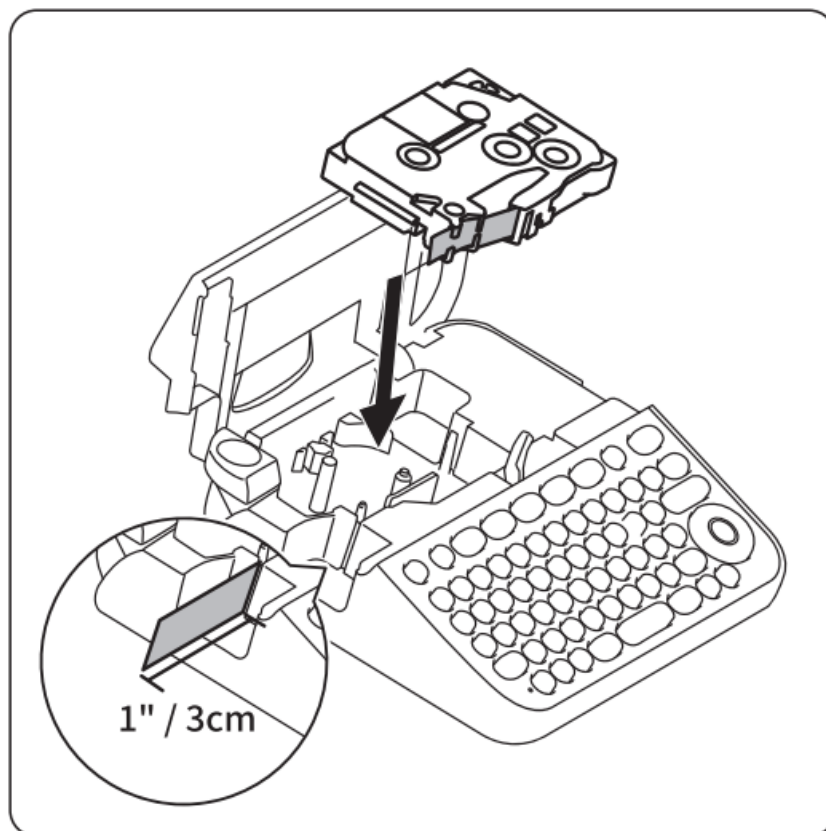
1. Charging until the power indicator doesn't flash (fully charged).



- Pull the tape out through the tape guides about 1" (3cm).
- Rotate the toothed wheel until it's tightened.



- Install the tape and pull out a section of the label about 1" (3cm) from the paper outlet.

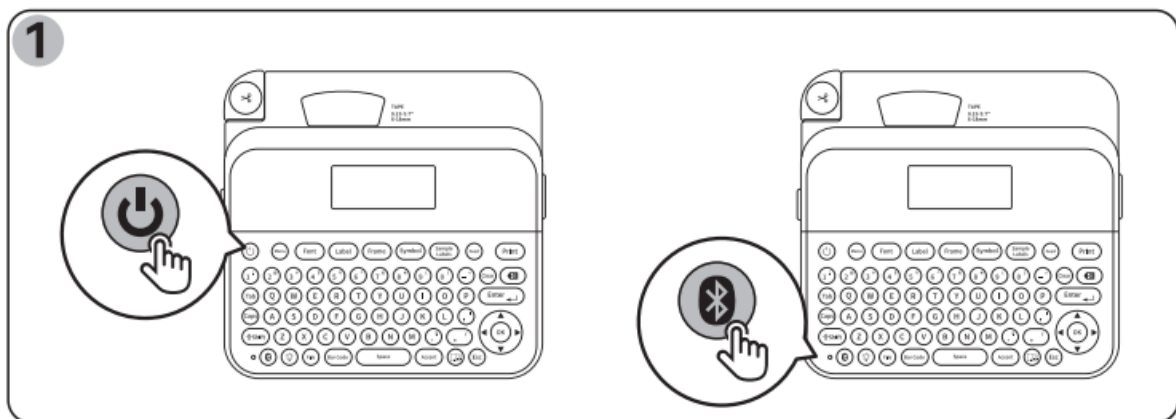

1. Turn on the printer and click the Bluetooth button.



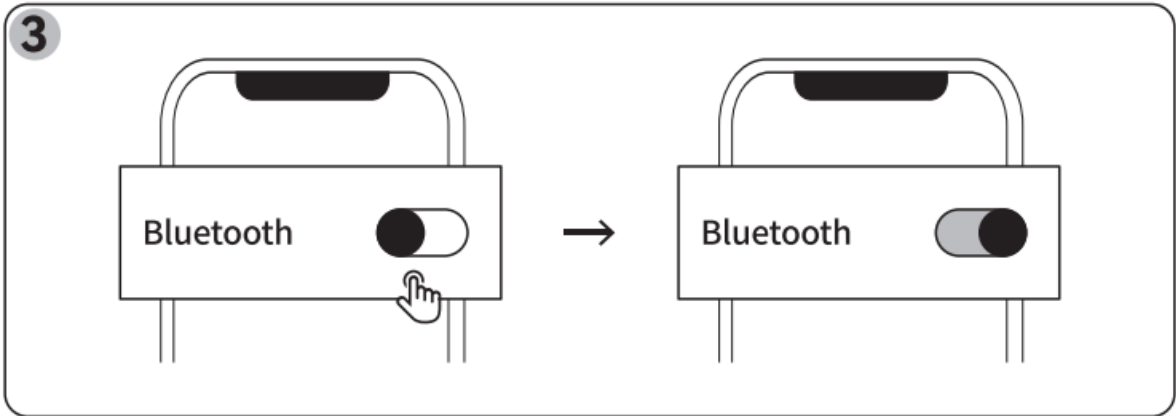
2. Scan to download App



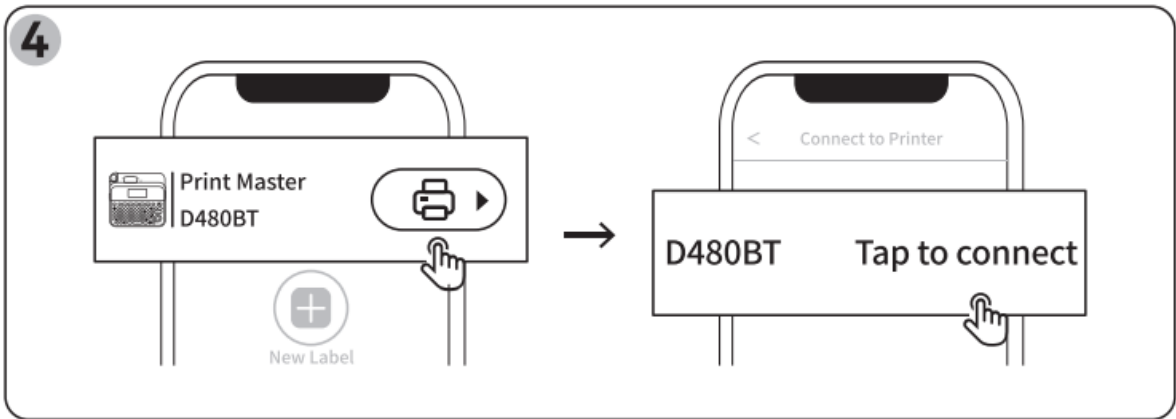
Print from Your Mobile Device
