Product Usage Instructions

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 2 new AAA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. Alkaline or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended for best performance.
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

WARNING: Adult assembly is required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Product Features

- 1. **English/Off/French Control Switch:** Slide the switch to English or French position to turn the unit On. Slide to Off position to turn it Off.
- 2. **Automatic Shut-Off:** The tablet will power down after 25 seconds without input to preserve battery life. Press any button to turn it On again.

Activities

Slide the English/Off/French Control Switch to turn the unit On. You'll hear a power-on sound effect, a sing-along song, and a playful phrase. The lights will flash with the sounds.

FAQ

- Q: What type of batteries should I use for the Tiny Tech Tablet?
 - A: The tablet requires 2 AAA batteries (AM-4/LR03). Alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended for best performance.
- Q: How can I dispose of old batteries and the product responsibly?
 - A: Do not dispose of batteries or the product in domestic waste. Look for collection points for proper disposal. Visit <u>www.recyclenow.com</u> for more information on recycling options near you.



Unlock the Packaging Locks


- 1. Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- 2. Pull out and discard the packaging locks.



INSTRUCTIONS

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 2 new AAA batteries (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

- Adult assembly required for battery installation.
- Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product

The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.



The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. English/Off/French Control Switch

To turn the unit On, slide the English/Off/French Control Switch to the English (ENG) or the French (FR) position. To turn the unit Off, slide the English/Off/French Control Switch to the Off () position.

2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the Tiny Tech Tablet will automatically power down after approximately 25 seconds without input. The unit can be turned On again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, we suggest changing the batteries.


ACTIVITIES


1. English/Off/French Control Switch

Slide the English/Off/French Control Switch to turn the unit On. You'll hear a power-on sound effect, a singalong song and a playful phrase. The lights will flash with the sounds.

2. Map Button

Press the Map Button to pretend to follow the map to various destinations, with phrases, and sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.







3. Music Button

Press the Music Button to hear a variety of melodies and two sing-along songs. The lights will flash with the sounds.

4. Entertainment Button

Press the Entertainment Button to hear amusing phrases about news, stories and music. The lights will flash with the sounds.





5. Exercise Button

Press the Exercise Button to listen to energetic sounds and phrases. The lights will flash with the sounds.

6. Camera Button


Press the Camera Button to enjoy playful role-play phrases and sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.





7. Calendar Button

Press the Calendar Button to listen to uplifting phrases and sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.






8. Mail Button

Press the Mail Button to discover numbers and hear counting sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.

9. Weather Button

Press the Weather Button to explore different weather conditions. The lights will flash with the sounds.






10. Lion Button

Press the Lion Button to hear Lion roaring sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.

11. Alarm Button

Press the Alarm Button to enjoy playful sounds and phrases announcing upcoming events. The lights will flash with the sounds.






12. Message Button

13. Elephant Button


Press the Elephant Button to hear elephants sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit is not working properly, install a brand new set of batteries.
