



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION



- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- 3. Install 2 new 'AAA' (AM-4 / LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- The toy is not to be connected to more than the recommended number of power supplies.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.




1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH To turn the unit ON, slide the ON/OFF/ VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH


- 2. **AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF** To preserve battery life, the VTech® Rhyme & Discover Book™ will automatically power-down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

ACTIVITIES

1. Slide the on/off/volume control switch to turn on the unit. You will hear an introductory phrase and song. The lights will flash with the sound.



- 2. Turn the book pages to hear fun phrases, sounds and songs. The lights will flash with the sound.
- 3. Slide or twist the moving parts to hear phrases relating to the nursery rhyme or a song. The lights will flash with the sound.
- 4. Press the music note button to hear songs or random melodies. The lights will flash with the sound.
- 5. Press the light-up animal buttons to hear the related animal sound and a song, a phrase encouraging you to turn the page or the animal singing along to a melody. The lights will flash with the sound.
- 6. If there is no input to the unit after approximately 10 seconds you will hear a short phrase. If there is no input for another 10 seconds, you will be asked to find one of the animals. If there continues to be no input, the unit will automatically power-down.

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the product dimensions of the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book?

The VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book measures 1.8 x 8 x 8.5 inches.

What is the weight of the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book?

The VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book weighs 1.1 pounds.

What age range is recommended for the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book?

The VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book is recommended for children aged 6 months to 3 years.

What type of batteries does the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book require?

The VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book requires 4 AAA batteries.

What should I do if the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book does not turn on?

Ensure the 4 AAA batteries are properly installed and not depleted. If the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book still does not turn on, try replacing the batteries with new ones.

How can I fix the issue if the lights on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book are not working?

Verify that the batteries are correctly installed and have sufficient charge. If the lights still do not work, try replacing the batteries with new ones.

What steps should I take if the sound on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book is too low or distorted?

Check the battery level and replace the batteries if necessary. Low battery power can cause sound issues in the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book.

How can I reset the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book if it freezes or becomes unresponsive?

Remove the 4 AAA batteries for a few minutes, then reinsert them. This can reset the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book and resolve any temporary issues.

What should I do if the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book does not turn on?

Ensure the 4 AAA batteries are properly installed and not depleted. If the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book still does not turn on, try replacing the batteries with new ones.

What should I do if the touch-sensitive areas on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book are not responding?

Ensure the surface is clean and free from debris. Gently clean the touch-sensitive areas with a dry cloth and check that the batteries are not depleted.

Why is my VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book intermittently turning off?

Check the battery compartment to ensure the batteries are securely in place. Loose batteries can cause the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book to turn off unexpectedly. Replace the batteries if the issue continues.

What can I do if the pages on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book are not triggering sounds or lights?

Make sure the pages are being fully turned and that there is no obstruction. Check the battery power and replace the batteries if needed.

How do I address the issue if the songs on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book are not playing?

Ensure the volume is turned up. If the volume is set correctly and the songs are still not playing, check and replace the batteries if necessary.


What should I do if the buttons on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book are sticking or hard to press?

Clean around the buttons with a dry cloth to remove any dirt or debris that may be causing them to stick. Avoid using water or liquid cleaners on the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book.

How can I resolve issues with the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book not switching between modes?

Turn off the VTech 80-027501 Rhyme and Discover Book, remove the batteries, and wait a few minutes before reinserting them. This can help reset the mode settings.
