Before You Spray

Prepare Surface and Mask

Prepare the surface you will be spraying and properly mask painting area.

Choose the Right Nozzle

This FLEXiO® sprayer comes with two spray nozzles designed to help you complete a variety of projects. iSpray® Fast coverage, large areas, thicker paints.

Detail Finish

Small projects, fine finishing, thin paints or stains.

Wagner SprayTech Corporation continually improves its products, therefore, there may be slight variations in appearance from those shown here.

Results may vary depending on coating, surface and experience.

Setup



Fill Cup
Paint or stain
(oil-based or latex).



Connect Nozzle
Turn and click.

Set Material Flow Control



iSpray

Start low (1-6) to practice and turn up (7-12) for fast covering.



Detail Finish

Turn left to decrease material flow and right to increase it.

Set Pattern Direction and Width



Adjust Pattern

Rotate for horizontal or vertical spray patterns.



Width Selector

Adjust for wide or narrow pattern.

Two-Speed Switch



High Speed

For paints and thicker materials.



Low Speed

For stains.

Spray

Quick Tip

Before spraying your home or furniture, do a test spray with water or use a spray poster.



Point and Pull

Point gun straight at surface, pull trigger.



Stay Close

Keep nozzle 6-8" from surface. Use full passes.

Note: See product manual for more information on spraying technique.

Quick Tip

Wipe the tip frequently to remove dried paint.

Clean

Note: Paint will smooth out as it dries.



Disconnect Nozzle

Pour remaining paint back into can and wash all parts.



Clean Thoroughly

Be sure to clean the suction tube air hole (see picture) located near the top and fully remove dried paint.

Quick Tip

Use soapy water for latex coatings and use mineral spirits for oil-based coatings.
