

DISCUSSION TIME: LESSON 1, CONNECT COFFEE TALK 1: INTIMACY AND IDENTITY

Leader BEGIN Discussion time by praying the Honor Code prayer or another short opening prayer **Leader SHARE** "In this lesson we'll discuss the first Connect Coffee Talk of Touching the Divine (Second Edition), Intimacy and Identity. Let's start by taking a look at question two in our study guides."

Leader ASK Q 2: "Have you been confused by any of the identity lies described by Henri Nouwen? (I am what I have. I am what I do. I am what others think of me.)" Leader SAY "Who is willing to get us started by sharing your thoughts? Did any one of those lies resonate with you?"

Leader NOTE Don't be afraid of a little silence after you first ask this question. Be prepared to share your insights if needed. If a participant shares, thank her with a warm comment and smile to help participants who are hesitant to realize that sharing is enriching and not intimidating.

Leader ASK Q1 & Q3

"What else from the talk stood out to you?"

AT-HOME WORK FOR NEXT SESSION;'

Leader ASK Women to complete Lesson 2: Jesus, the Word of God. Encourage them to dedicate 15 minutes each day (5 days of the week) to work on the lesson.

Leader REMIND Everyone of the day and time of the next session

PRAYER INTENTIONS

Leader EXPLAIN

Part of the small group experience is praying specifically for one another throughout the week. We'llexperience Christ in a personal way when we ask Him for help with our specific needs. While we often think first of the needs of the world and people we care about, WWP encourages the use of this time to specifically ask for prayers for ourselves. For example, you may request prayers for patience, for a relationship that needs mending, self-discipline to manage time, etc."

"Prayer intentions are treated with respect and confidentiality. The time is not intended for delving intodetails that may lead to gossip. When sharing an intention about a struggle with another person, all efforts should be made to keep it general and anonymous."

Leader ASK Women to take turns sharing their prayer intention. Others can write down prayer requests on the Prayer Pages found in the back of their study guides.

Leader LEAD By example with your own prayer intention

Leader PRAY Aloud for each woman by name, trying to include what was shared. Close by praying a

personalprayer, the Touching the Divine prayer (found in the back of the study guide at the beginning of the Prayer Pages), or a Hail Mary for the intentions.

Leader ASK Q 2-5 quickly (factual)

Leader ASK For reflections on QYH section: "What stood out to you? What resonated with you?"

DAY TWO THE CLEANSING OF THE TEMPLE

Leader ASK Q1 A, B & C

Leader ASK Q 2, 3A, & 3B (all factual)

Group SHARE Responses to Q 3C

Leader READ QYH aloud, inviting participants to underline those phrases that speak to them personally.C

DAY THREE JESUS AND NICODEMUS

CDCCCC"As I read John 3:1–15, I invite you to close your eyes and place yourself in the middle of thisstory. Imagine what was going through Nicodemus' mind." Read John 3:1–15.

Group SHARE Responses to Q1A & 1B

Leader ASK Q 2 A, B, & C (factual)

Leader READ Q 3 aloud, then ask for volunteers willing to share their "before and after" testimony.

Leader ASK Q 4 & 5

DAY FOUR GOD'S LOVE FOR THE WORLD

Leader NOTE John 3:16 is the VERSE STUDY at the end of the lesson

Leader ASK Q 1 A,B, & C (factual)

Leader ASK Volunteer to read John 3:17 and 2 Peter 3:9, referring to Q2

Leader ASK Q2, Q3, then ASK for a volunteer to read paragraph following Q3unteer READ Last paragraph of QYH beginning with "Jesus was preparing..."C

Group SHARE Responses to Q4

Leader ASK If anyone relates to the belief noted in QYH that we must be "cleaned up" to be loved by God. Leave some time for discussion.

DAY FIVE JESUS ABOVE ALL

Leader READ Q1, both paragraphs. Then ASK "How can John the Baptist's example help us to grow in contentment?"

Leader ASK Q2, Q3 A & B, and Q4 A

Leader READ Q4B

Group SHARE Responses Q4B, allow extra time for discussion

Leader NOTE QYH prayer would make a great closing prayer at the end of your meeting

CONCLUSION

Leader ASK "Based on this week's lesson, how do the verses, 'Do whatever he tells you' (John 2:5) and 'He must increase, but I must decrease' (John 3:30), impact you? What resonated with you from the Conclusion?"

VERSE STUDY

Leader REMIND Participants to refer to the appendix for a reminder on how to do a verse study

- Leader NOTE The jobs of the Holy Spirit, as listed in the QYH; encourage women to use this QYH in their personal prayer to intercede for loved ones

DAY TWO SORROW TURNED TO JOY

- Leader ASK Q1 & Q2
- Group SHARE Responses to Q3 & Q4, asking for a volunteer to READ Romans 8:18 and 2 Corinthians 4:16–
 18
- Leader READ Paragraph following Q4, beginning at the quote from Saint Ignatius, "Let the fire, the gallows, the wild beasts..."

DAY THREE PEACE FOR THE DISCIPLES

- Leader ASK Q1 & Q2, noting Romans 8:15–17 and CCC 2777
- Group SHARE Responses to Q3
- Leader NOTE Hebrews 4:16 as how God desires we approach Him always
- Leader ASK Q4, refer to answer key for insight
- Leader NOTE QYH and contemplating the virtue of fortitude; encourage use of the passage from Jesus Calling in personal pray

DAY FOUR JESUS PRAYS FOR HIS CHURCH

- Leader READ Paragraph prior to Q1, noting the high priestly prayer of Jesus
- Leader SAY "As the High Priests of the Old Testament would offer prayers for the people of Israel to the Lord in the Temple, so Jesus is our High Priest, interceding for us to God the Father. This prayer of Jesus can be used as a model for our own intercessory prayer—petitions for ourselves, petitions for others, petitions for those outside of the Church."
- Group SHARE Responses to Q1 & Q2, refer to answer key for further explanation on Q1
- Volunteer READ Two paragraphs following Q2
- Leader ASK For the group's insight on how we can follow Christ and avoid a holy huddle
- Leader ASK Q3 A, B, & C
- Leader NOTE How we are called to pray for the shepherds of our Church: ordained as priests, bishops, and deacons. Encourage women to use the QYH prayer to pray for protection over our shepherds

DAY FIVE THE PRAYER FOR UNITY

- Leader ASK Q1 & Q2
- Group SHARE Responses to Q3 & Q4
- · Leader NOTE The urgency that Saint John Paul II spoke in the quote following Q4
- Leader READ The quote from Justin Martyr in the QYH; ask the women to contemplate what the world might be like if Christians were as united as they were in the Early Church

CONCLUSION

- Leader ASK For personal insights from the Conclusion: "What resonated with you? What did you underline/highlight?"
- VERSE STUDY Leader ASK Participants to share any thoughts they came up with from the verse study

 - ensure the best possible outcome for themselves
- Leader ASK Q3, noting in Matthew 26 the response to Jesus accepting the charge of being the Son of God
- Group SHARE Responses to Q4 A & B
- Volunteer READ Paragraph following Q4 B
- Leader ASK Q4 C; ask the group to place themselves in Peter's shoes, receiving the gaze of Jesus in that moment

Leader NOTE The beautiful reflection by Beth Moore in QYH, then READ the last paragraph of the QYH

DAY THREE JESUS BEFORE PILATE

- Leader ASK Q1 A & B, noting the paragraph following Q1 B
- Leader ASK Q2 & Q3, use answer key for further insights
- · Volunteer READ QYH

DAY FOUR JESUS SENTENCED TO DEATH

- Leader ASK Q1 A, B, Q2 A, & B, use answer key for reference for Q1 B, Q2 A, & B
- Group SHARE Responses to Q3 A & B
- Leader ASK For a volunteer to read Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI's quote in between Q3 A & B
- Volunteer READ Q4, Leader ask for group to share insights
- Leader READ QYH, noting the difference between self-reliance and relying on Christ

DAY FIVE JESUS AND HEROD

- Leader NOTE We were asked to read passages in both John 18 and Luke 23
- Leader ASK Q1, Q2 A & B

- · Leader READ Q4, asking for group to share personal insights
- Volunteer READ QYH

CONCLUSION

Leader SAY "This conclusion is meant to be convicting. The people decided to release Barabbas, a known criminal, rather than Jesus, a gentle, peaceful teacher. Jesus didn't just want to teach and preach. Hewanted to change hearts and change lives. What resonated with you? What did you\underline/highlight?" Allow time for discussion and sharing.

- Leader SAY "The radical love and obedience that Jesus shows in John 19 is the same that we are called to.

 How often do we, like Pilate, choose our own plans, choose to look after ourselves rather than obey what
- God is commanding? Can we trust that obeying God will truly lead to the abundant life promised in John 10:10? What is holding us back from complete trust in God's plans?

- Leader ASK Q1, Q2, & Q3 A
- Group SHARE Responses to Q3 B, first part; second part is more personal
- Leader ASK Q4 (factual)
- Group SHARE Responses to Q5, noting who John the Apostle represents at the foot of the Cross in that moment.
- Refer to the answer key for further explanation
- Leader READ Passage from Venerable Fulton Sheen's book, Life of Christ
- · Leader ASK Group to contemplate the divine exchange noted in the QYH: "He takes our sins, our failings, our
- inadequacies and, by the power of the cross, applies His forgiveness and mercy, transforming us into His image and likeness. He does this because He loves us." How are we to respond?

DAY FIVE JESUS' SIDE IS PIERCED

- · Leader ASK Q1
- Group SHARE Responses to Q2 A, B & C; Leader ask for volunteers to read each Scripture verse and CCC clip and respond; refer to answer key for further insight
- Leader ASK Q3

CONCLUSION

• Leader NOTE If time permits, the Leader may want to read the entire Conclusion, as it is very powerful. If time does not allow, ask the group to share their responses to reading the detailed description of what happens to a human body during the act of crucifixion as offered by Dr. C. Truman Davis. End byreading the last two paragraphs of the Conclusion, beginning, "And what were His words?
