WATTS PSG Push-On Gasket with Test Cap


NOTICE Inquire with governing authorities for local installation requirements

Typical Installation

- 1. Ensure drainage pipe is cut square and free of any burrs or sharp edges.
- 2. Lubricate both the gasket and outside diameter pipe.
- 3. Insert the gasket into the drain body.
- 4. Press the drain assembly onto the pipe until it bottoms out.

To Remove the Test Cap

- 1. Using a sharp blade, cut the gasket in the u-shaped area marked with arrows, as shown in Figure A.
- 2. Grab loop on top of the gasket and pull upwards. The cap will rip out in a circular pattern, as shown in Figure B.
- 3. Trim edges with knife if needed.
