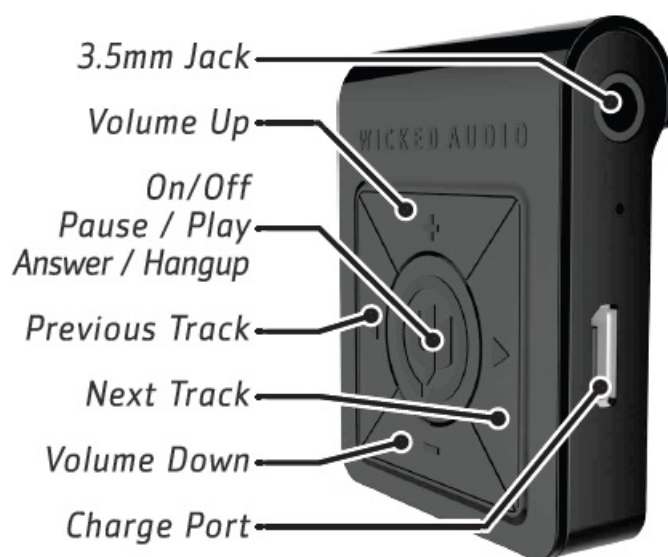

USER MANUAL

KEEP YOUR FAVORITE HEADPHONES! WITH THE REACH BLUETOOTH AUDIO RECEIVER, THEY'RE ALL WIRELESS NOW PLUG IN ANY HEADPHONE OR EARBUD AND THE REACH WILL TAKE CARE OF THE REST.

QUICK SETUP



1. Make sure The Reach is charged.
2. Have your phone (or other Bluetooth device) on with the Bluetooth feature enabled.

3. Turn on The Reach. Hold down center button until the LED flashes red and blue.
4. Your phone (or other Bluetooth device) will detect "Wicked Reach."
5. Select "Wicked Reach" to pair. Once successfully paired, the LEO will slowly flash blue.



HOW TO USE THE REACH

<i>FUNCTION</i>	<i>DESCRIPTION</i>	<i>INDICATION</i>
POWERING ON	Hold down center button until L.E.D. flashes blue.	Single beep Flashing blue
PAIRING MODE	The Reach automatically enters pairing mode when turned on.	Flashing red and blue
RECONNECTING	If you have previously connected to The Reach it will automatically search for and connect with the last known device.	Flashing red and blue
SUCCESSFULLY PAIRED	The Reach will indicate when successfully paired. The device is now ready to rock!	"Connected" Slow flashing blue
DISCONNECTED	If The Reach disconnects it will automatically revert into pairing mode and begin searching for a device to connect to.	"Disconnected" Flashing red and blue
ANSWER/ HANGUP	Press the center button to answer an incoming call.	Ringtone Solid blue
	Press the center button to end call.	Solid blue
MAXIMUM VOLUME	Press + button to increase volume.	Single tone
MINIMUM VOLUME	Press - button to decrease volume.	
NEXT TRACK	Press ▶ button to skip to the next track	
BEGINNING OF TRACK	Press ◀ button to start current track at the beginning.	
PREVIOUS TRACK	Double click ◀ button to play previous track.	

<i>FUNCTION</i>	<i>DESCRIPTION</i>	<i>INDICATION</i>
PAUSE / PLAY	Press center button to pause track. Press again to resume play.	Playing: Solid blue Paused: Flashing blue
POWERING OFF	Hold down center button until L.E.D quickly flashes blue.	Single beep Flashing blue

CHARGING

<i>F U N C T I O N</i>	<i>D E S C R I P T I O N</i>	<i>I N D I C A T I O N</i>
LOW BATTERY	The Reach will notify when the battery is at 20% charge or less. A reminder will sound every 5 minutes until the battery is dead or charging begins. <i>It is recommended to charge soon for uninterrupted play.</i>	"Low charge"
CHARGING <i>While powered off</i>		Solid red
CHARGING <i>While powered on</i>		Solid red with slow flashing blue or solid blue
FULLY CHARGED <i>While powered off</i>		Red L.E.D. turns off
FULLY CHARGED <i>While powered on</i>		Red L.E.D. turns off and product returns to slow flashing blue or solid blue

PRECAUTIONS

LISTENING TO AUDIO AT EXCESSIVE VOLUMES CAN CAUSE PERMANENT HEARING DAMAGE. USE AS LOW A VOLUME AS POSSIBLE.
