

Specifications:

• Compliance: Part 15 of FCC Rules

• Radiation Exposure Limits: FCC approved for uncontrolled environment

• Minimum Distance: 0cm between radiator and body

Product Usage Instructions

Safety Precautions:

- 1. Do not make any changes or modifications to the device that are not explicitly approved by the manufacturer.
- 2. Ensure the device is operated within the recommended guidelines to prevent harmful interference.
- 3. Maintain a minimum distance of 0cm between the radiator and your body during operation.

Installation:

- 1. Place the device on a stable surface with adequate ventilation.
- 2. Connect the necessary cables according to the provided instructions.

Operation:

- 1. Power on the device using the designated power button.
- 2. Follow the user manual for specific instructions on device operation.

Maintenance:

- 1. Regularly clean the device exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- 2. Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures or moisture.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Can I modify the device for better performance?

A: No, any changes not approved by the manufacturer can void your warranty and affect device operation.

• Q: Is it safe to use the device close to my body?

A: The device should be operated with a minimum distance of 0cm between the radiator and your body as per FCC regulations.

USE WIRELESS HEADSET

- **Power on:** Open the charging case, and the earphones will automatically power on. (Manual power on) Press the MFB touch button for about 3 seconds.
- **Power off:** Put the earphones into the charging case will automatically power off. (Manual power off) Press the MFB touch button for about 5 seconds.
- Answer/hang up: Click the L or R MFB touch button for answer/ double-click the L or R MFB touch button for hang up.
- Reject: Long press the L or R MFB touch button for about 2 seconds;
- Music play/pause: Click the L or R MFB touch button;
- **Volume** +/-: Double-click the L ear MFB touch button volume / double -click the R ear MFB touch button volume +;
- Volume increase or decrease during a call: Press and hold the MFB button on the left ear for about 1 second before the volume starts to decrease. Release the MFB button on the right ear and hold it for about 1 second before the volume starts to increase and stops;
- last /next songs: Triple-click the L ear MFB touch button (last song) / triple-click the R ear MFB touch button (next song);
- **Voice switching:** When the earphone is powered on and not connected, double-click the L or R MF B touch button.
- **Voice Assistant:** Press and hold the left and right MFB touch keys for about 3 seconds, release to enter the voice assistant, and click to exit.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Safety code

- Do not disassemble your Wireless headset at any time, because it may damage your Wireless headset or
 cause the battery to self-ignite. Please take the wireless headset to the designated service point for repair, or
 replace the battery.
- 2. When you drive with a Wireless headset, please follow the regulations of your country on region.
- 3. Aviod putting the Wireless headset in a high-temperature environment < higher than 50 ° C/122° f such as exposure to the sun, which will damage the performance of the Wireless headset and reduce the battery use life.

Don't the Wireless headset get wet or immersed in liquid

If the headset can be used for Notebook, PC, Desktop computer and Pad?	Yes, the headset can be used for the devices that support blutooth version and functions
Why I hear the mute and disturbance sound while calling?	Cordless telephones and wireless network devices and other similar devices may generate disturbance, which be usually heard like static noise.
Whether the headset disturb the on-board electronic devices radio or computer?	No, the frequency generated by the headset is far below the frequency generated by common mobile phones.
Why an echo is heard while calling?	Adjust the volume or move to other area and try again
How to clean the headset?	Clean with dry and soft cloth
The headset can not be fully charged?	The headset and the charging cable may not be connected well. Please try agai
