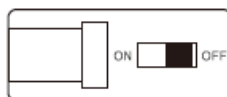

Mode Setting and Repairing



Bluetooth Mode

Turn the switch to the “ON” position, hold down the FN+Q/W/E key combination, and the corresponding key will blink quickly. After the Bluetooth connection is successful, the backlight of the key will be restored

If the device has already been paired, press FN+Q/W/E briefly to reconnect

2.4G Mode

Turn the switch to the “ON” position, long press the FN+R key, the R key light flashes quickly, insert the receiver, and restore the backlight after the pairing is successful

If the device has already been paired, press FN+R briefly and plug in the 2.4G receiver to reconnect

Wired Mode

Turn the switch to the “ON” position ,press FN+T, plug in the TYPE-C cable, and enter the wired mode

Low Battery Warning: When the battery is low, the ESC red light blinks slowly. When charging, the ESC red light is steady on

FN+Enter	Switch backlight colors
FN+Backspace	Switch backlight effects

FN+Space	Check the battery level

FAQ

- ## 1. How do I switch between Bluetooth and wired modes?

Use the FN+Q/W/E key combination for Bluetooth mode and FN+T for wired mode.


- ## 2. What should I do if the keyboard is not connecting via Bluetooth?

Ensure the switch is in the “ON” position and hold down the FN+Q/W/E key combination to reconnect.

- ### 3. How can I check the battery level?

Press FN+Space to check the battery level.
