


Network Configuration

1. Power on the product.




Anticlockwise rotating the battery cover to open



Remove the battery insulation film to power on the product

2. Press the RESET button for 3s and release, the red LED will flash for network configuration.




3. Set the zigbee gateway to add device status on the APP (Refer to the gateway manual), search for the device.


Note: Zigbee sensors must be connected to a Zigbee gateway in order to use.

Installation Instructions

1. Use a 3M sticker to affix the product to the target position.



2. Put the sensor suitable place.
