What's the difference between Similac Pro-Sensitive, Similac Pro-Advance®, Similac Pro-Total Comfort™, and other Similac baby formulas?

Similac Pro-Advance is our closest baby formula to breast milk. Similac Pro-Advance, Similac Pro-Sensitive, and Similac Pro-Total Comfort now have 2'-FL HMO (Human Milk Oligosaccharide*), a unique immune-nourishing prebiotic. However, our other Similac baby formulas also provide complete nutrition for babies. It's up to parents, along with their doctor, to choose which formula to feed their baby.

The following Similac products are considered suitable for babies with lactose sensitivity or suitable for lactose intolerance: Similac Pro-Sensitive,* Similac Sensitive®,* Similac Pro-Total Comfort,* and Similac® For Spit-Up.*

NOTE: Other Similac baby formulas contain lactose and are not suitable for lactose intolerance.
