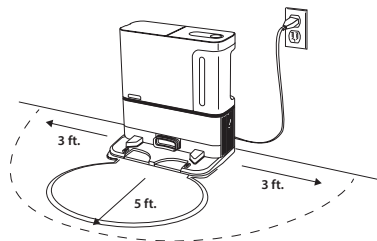

Robot Setup:

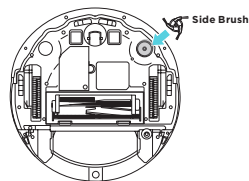
1 Set Up Base + Landing Mat

- Remove protective film from the robot and base.
- Snap together the pieces of the landing mat.
- Place the base on top of the landing mat, in a location with a strong Wi-Fi signal.

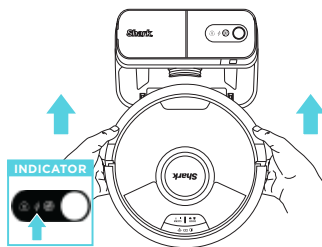


2 Attach Side Brush

- Note: Side brush design may vary.



3 Place Robot on Base

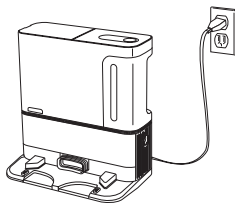

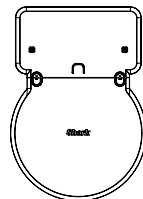
What's Included:

Self-Empty Base



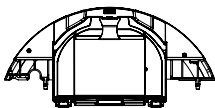
Holds 60 days' worth of debris.

Landing Mat



Sits under the Self-Empty Base and robot.

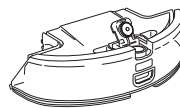
Self-Empty Dust Bin



Enables Self-Empty feature for dry vacuuming.

Note: the Self-Empty Dust Bin comes pre-inserted in the robot.

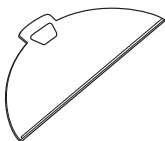
VAC & MOP 2-in-1 Dust Bin



Enables mopping mode while holding dry debris from vacuuming.

Note: The VAC & MOP 2-in-1 Dust Bin will not self-empty. It will require manual cleaning after use.

Reusable mopping pad for vacuuming and mopping mode.

- To manually turn ON /OFF your robot, hold down the **DOCK** button for 6-8 seconds.
- Clear the area of cords and wires before each clean.
- Use mopping mode for daily maintenance and stuck-on messes.
- Only use Shark® VACMOP™ cleaning solution or water when mopping.
- Always place your robot on a level surface when performing maintenance.
- Clean brushroll and filter regularly.
