





## FAQ:

Q1 What should I do if the keyboard become sticky after a period ofusage?

A1: This usually happens due to low power. Please replace the batteryon the keyboard and try again.

Q2 What should I do if I can't type with the keyboard?

A2: Please make sure whether the keyboard can be turned on. If you can't turn on the keyboard, please change the battery and try again, if itstill won't work, please contact us if you can turn on the keyboard just itwon't type, please try repairing the keyboard with the USB receiver.

Q3:What should I do if my mouse stopped working?

A3:Please confirm whethe the mouse can be turned on. If you can't successfully turn on the mouse, change the battery and try again. If it still cannot function properly, please contact us.

#### How to repair the keyboard to the USB receiver


Step 1.Insert the USB receiver and place the keyboard as closely possible to the USB receiver.

Step 2.Press and hold the keyboard "ESC" + "K" keys together to pair again



## How to repair the mous to the USB receiver

Step1:Take out the battery and USB receiver, reload the battery and plug the receiver into the computer,for the mouse to enter a full reset. Step2. Press and hold the Left button and the Right button with Scroll button with together to pair again.




#### **Indicator Function Instruction**
