**Product Diagram** 



1	Short press to turn down volume of the speaker Long press to switch to the previous song
2	Long press to POWER ON/OFF the machine Short press to PLAY/PAUSE the music
3	Short press to turn up volume of the speaker Long press to switch to the next song
4	Long press to turn on/off LED dancing light Short press to switch modes(TF/Bluetooth)
5	Meadphone Port
6	TF card port
7	Charging port 5V-1A
8	Working Indicator

9	(1)	Press and hold for 2-3s to turn ON/OFF the microphone. Short press to PAUSE/PLAY music remotely.
10	<b>①</b>	Short press to turn up microphone volume, there are 5 levels of mic volume.  Long Press 2-3s to turn up <b>echo volume</b> , there are 5 levels of echo volume. (The default echo is 0)
11	•	Short press to turn down microphone volume, total 5 levels of mic vol. Long Press 2-3s to turn down <b>echo volume</b> , total 5 levels of echo vol.(The default echo is 0)
12	<b>S</b>	Short press to switch between 4 kinds of magic voices Long press 2-3s to remove/restore music vocals (Part of IOS music not supported)
13		Working Indicator
14	0	Charging port for microphone 5V-1A

# How to use the speaker

- Power ON/OFF: Press and hold for 2-3s to turn ON/OFF. And short-press press +
   button to adjust the volume of the speaker.
- 2. Bluetooth Connection: Turn on the speaker, and press **M** button to switch to Bluetooth mode,there is a voice" Bluetooth" and search the Bluetooth name" **K1-L**", click and paired.
- 3. Previous/Next Song: Long press + and hold for 2- 3s to switch to next/previous song.
- 4. Play music via TF card: Prepare a micro SD card loaded with MP3 songs, plug the card into the TF card slot of the speaker, it will auto play.

# How to use the microphone

## 1. Power ON/OFF

Press and hold for 2-3s to turn ON/OFF the microphone.

The mic and speaker will auto-connect with each other when both are powered on.

## 2. How to adjust the microphone volume?

Short press + – to turn up/down the microphone volume, there are 5 levels of mic volume. When reaching the highest or the lowest volume, there will be a prompt voice" du du"

# 3. How to adjust the echo volume?

Long Press + for 2- 3s to turn up echo volume, long press once to turn up 1 level, total 5 levels of echo volume.

Long Press – for 2- 3s to turn down echo volume, long press once to turn down 1 level, total 5 levels of echo volume.

Note: The default echo is 0, pls long-press + to turn up the echo volume to a suitable level for a better singing/karaoke effect.

# 4. Magic Sound Effect

Short press to switch between 4 kinds of magic voices


Long press 2- 3s to remove/restore music vocals (Part of music for iOS not supported)

# **How to Charge**


- 1. Take out the Type-C charging cable included in the package
- 2. Plug the Type-C end of the cable into the machine or microphone, and the other USB end into a normal USB charging adaptor/PC Port (5V, 1A-2A)
- 3. When the speaker/mic is being charged, the indicator light turns red. Once it is fully charged, the indicator light will turn off.

#### **FAQ**

- The mic is no sound.
  - o Try to charge the mic and use it
  - Try to long-press the mic to turn on
  - The speaker and mic are not connected successfully.
  - Pls restart them and turn up the mic volume to try again.
- The machine makes no sound when playing music.
  - Check whether the Bluetooth is connected successfully
  - Check if the sound was paused via the mic end, if yes, short press of the mic
     to PLAY/PAUSE the music
  - Check if the phone volume is turned up
  - $\circ\,$  Short press + of the speaker to turn up the speaker's volume

### Bluetooth can't be paired

Press M button to switch to Bluetooth mode first Distant Bluetooth connection, try to adjust the distance between the karaoke machine and the phone. The karaoke machine already paired with other phone. First turn off Bluetooth of other phones and restart the machine, try to pair with phone again.

Presence of noise

Environmental noise, or mobile phone signal interference, Adjust the distance between the karaoke machine and the cellphone, and adjust the distance between the mic and the machine

Long press the power button and the machine/mic indicator does not light up;

Try to charge the device/mic and use it

Bluetooth can't be connected

Pls press M button to switch to Bluetooth mode first If the speaker has been connected to another bluetooth device, pls turn off the other Bluetooth first.

Microphone volume too low

Pls turn up both echo and mic volume to try.

Microphone doesn't work

Fully charge the speaker and the mic, and restart them to connect again.
