Product Overview



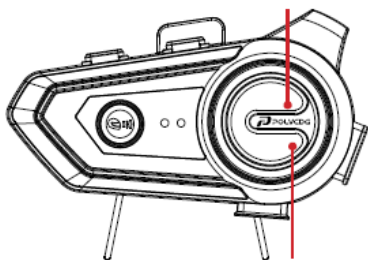
Important Reminder:

Before installing the headset, please connect your mobile phone according to the quick manual guide to test the sound effect and volume.

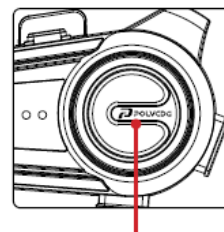
If there is a big difference in sound effect and volume after installing into the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker inside the helmet.

Double-tap to toggle voice announcement (disconnect wireless)



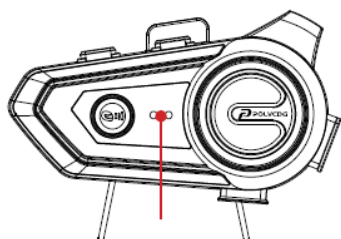
Boot-up beep



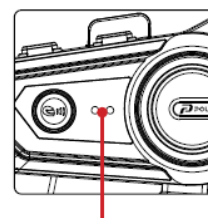
Press and hold for 3 seconds

Wireless connection



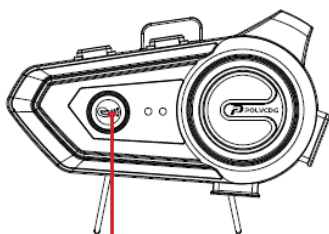
Wireless Mode Tone

under successful wireless pairing

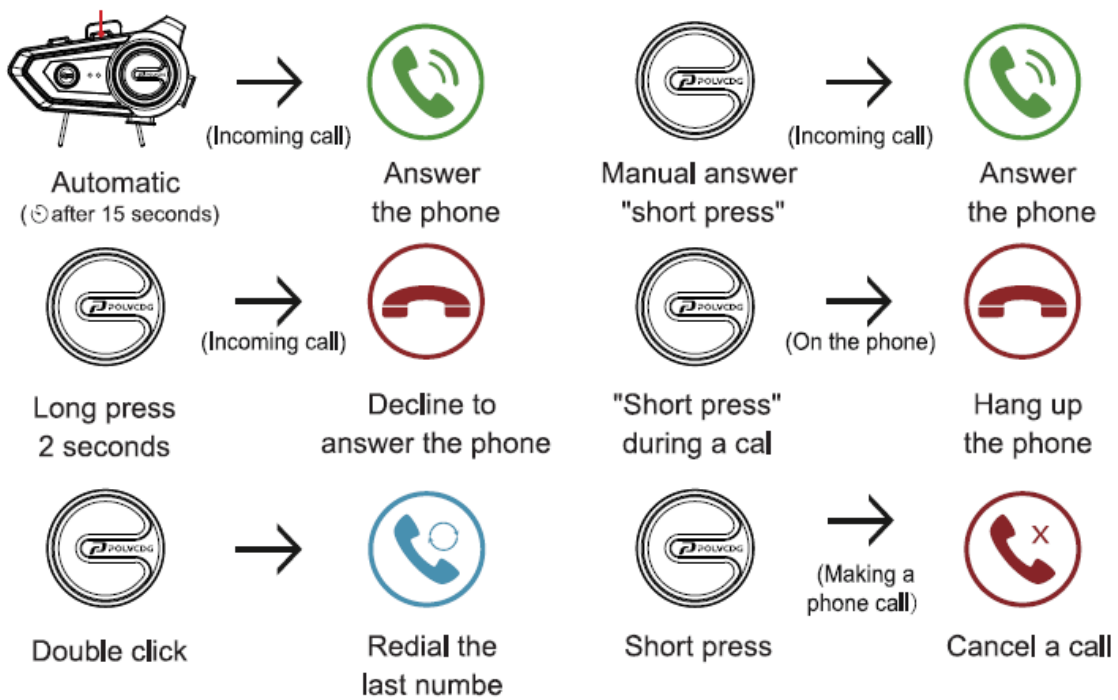


Short press the “Voice assistant key”
to Wake up the voice assistant.

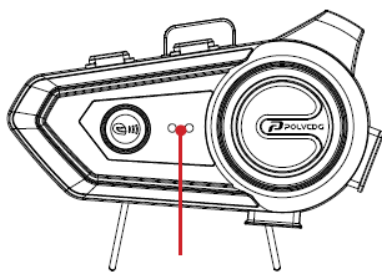
Short press again to exit

Double-tap to toggle manual/ automatic answer (when not connected to wireless)



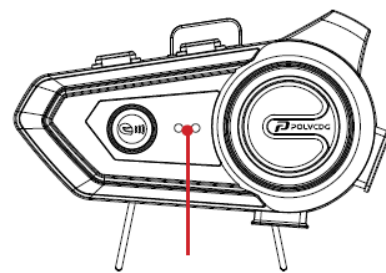
Charging function

Playable

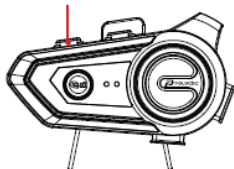


(while music is playing)

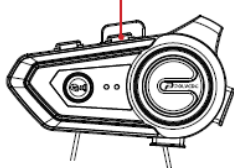

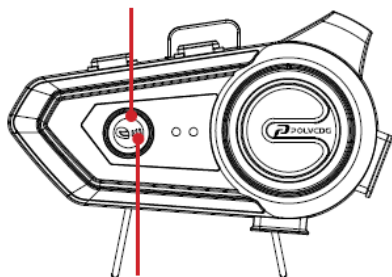

BASS

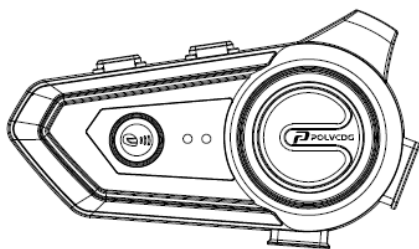

Caveat
