Copy EDID: Output 8 is the priority port. When output 8 is connected to one display, another display which is connected to other outputs will follow the resolution of output 8.

Auto: Default resolution is 4K@60Hz.

Mixed EDID: Always follow the lowest resolution of the displays connected to 4 outputs in order to support all displays.

- 1. The HDCP Version is prior to EDID. When the source is HDCP 2.2, if the TV supports HDCP 2.2, it will output 4K@60Hz. If the TV doesn't support HDCP 2.2, it will output 1080P.
- 2. Supports HDR under Copy EDID and Mixed EDID modes.



Copy EDID:

Output 8 ispriority port. When output 8 is connected toone display, another display which connected to other outputs will follow the Resolution of output 8.

Auto:

Default 4K@60Hz

Mixed EDID:

Always follow the lowest resolution of the displays connected to 4 outputs in order to support all displays show the source.


