## Naming of Audio Files When Long Recordings Are Split:

When the maximum file size is exceeded during recording, the file will be split. A sequential number (long recording file number) will be added to the audio file name. Follow these steps:

1. Refer to the operation manual for setting the maximum file size (File Max Size).

#### Functions revised and added in Version 6.4

rather than with the take number increased by one.

- Changed naming of audio files when long recordings are split
   When the maximum file size (File Max Size) is exceeded, a new audio file will be created with a sequential num-ber (long recording file number) added to its name
- Resumption of audio interface mode when restarting enabled

  If the unit was shut down during audio interface mode, this mode will automatically be reactivated when next started up.
- Function added to show an SD card formatting menu at startup
   An SD card formatting menu can be shown by pressing a specific button during startup.

## Naming of audio files when long recordings are split

- When the maximum file size (File Max Size) is exceeded during recording, the file will be split. Now, however, a sequential number (long recording file number) will be added to the audio file name.
- See the operation manual for information about setting the maximum file size (File Max Size).

Version	Audio file name example (for stereo file)	Explanation
Previous version	Scene001_T002_Tr1_2.wav	① Take number
	1	The take number is advanced by one each time the file is split. (For example: T001, T002, T003)
Version 6.4	Scene001_T001_0002_Tr1_2.wav	① Sequential number (long recording file number) The long recording file number is advanced by one each time the file is split. (For example: 0001, 0002, 0003)


## Showing a menu to format SD cards at startup

#### **NOTE**

Be aware that all data on the SD card will be deleted when it is formatted.

## SD cards can be formatted by pressing a specific button during startup.

- 1. Insert an SD card.
- 2. Turn on the power while pressing the (REC) button.



3. Use the (selection encoder) to select the slot with the SD card to format. Then, press the (selection encoder).



4. Use the (selection encoder) to select "Yes". Then, press the encoder).



SD Card formatting will start.

#### **HINT**

• SD cards can also be formatted from the Menu Screen.
